How do I sign up?

Registration is online now; see the last page of this catalog for instructions. Sign up by Friday, December 12. DO NOT send payment; we'll bill you.

Can I opt out of the Aftercare fee that's bundled into the class price?

No, we've included a \$10/day (reduced-rate) Aftercare with every class (and music lesson), so it's easier than ever to take classes. There is no option to take a class without being enrolled in Aftercare. Students can be picked up anytime, but have the option to stay as late as 6:00 on class days.

How do I fill out the Monthly Dismissal Plan when my student is enrolled in Enrichment?

You'll get a class confirmation email before the December Dismissal Plan deadline. Mark your December Dismissal Plan for AFTERCARE on the days you have Enrichment classes.

What happens if the minimum number of kids don't sign up for a class?

Sadly, we have to cancel classes that don't reach minimum numbers. We'll contact you via email if that happens.

Can I cancel a class?

No, we depend on enrollment numbers to move forward with a class, so we consider you committed after Dec. 12. You will be billed for the class.

When do classes start?

Classes begin the week of Jan. 5, once a week for eight weeks, ending the week of Feb. 23. Monday classes do not meet on Jan. 19 and Feb. 16. The printed school calendar says there are no classes the week of Jan. 19; wrong! None on Monday, but they run the rest of that week.

How long are classes?

Most classes are 45 minutes in length. Exceptions are Chess Club and Lego Enginetics (1 hour long).

Where (and when) do I pick up my kids after Enrichment classes?

Every enrichment student needs to be signed out at our Aftercare table near door 2. There are three-ring binders organized by last name, and a sheet for each student. Sign on the line for the current day. We'll call for your student when you have signed out.

What if my kids are sick, or someone else has to pick them up?

Call the office and let us know if your kids won't be there. If someone else is picking them up, let the office know; that person will need to show an ID.

What else do I need to know?

Please remind your students that behavior expectations for Aftercare and Enrichment are the same as they are in the classroom.

Classes meet once a week for 8 weeks. **Monday classes meet 6 times.** Class periods are 4:00-4:45 and 5:00-5:45, with Chess Club meeting 4:00-5:00 and Lego Enginetics meeting 5:00-6:00. Classes begin the week of January 5. Make-up week, if a class is cancelled for weather or teacher illness, is the week of March 9. No classes January 19, but classes DO meet the rest of that week.


