About Our Camp

Intended for current (and former) Yinghua students in grades 6 through 9 (entering grades 7 through 10 in the fall), this camp is designed to help students continue learning Chinese language and literature, to engage students with technology, leadership, and character development, and to motivate them to become role models for younger learners in Chinese language learning.

Week 1 (July 27 to August 1): students will take a language course on site in the morning, and receive leadership training in the afternoon. The language course, developed by Dr. Luyi Lien and Yinghua Middle School teachers and tailored to Yinghua students, will be delivered online in partnership with Minnesota Online High School (MNOHS) and give students an opportunity to earn future high school credit*.

Weeks 2 and 3 (August 3 to August 14): students will continue with the language course and complete their service learning component by working alongside language coaches in the summer camp for students in grades K through 5.

***During the summer camp, students will have a chance to begin to complete 1/4 of the regular credit course. Students eligible to attend high school must sign up for this course with MNOHS in the fall to complete the remaining 3/4 of this course in order to receive high school credit.**
