Everything you need to know about Enrichment classes

NOTE: Classes are open to grades 1 to 8 in Session I. Kindergarten students can register for winter and spring session classes.

How do I sign up for Enrichment classes?

Registration is online. See the last page of this catalog for instructions. Sign up by 5p.m. Friday, September 8. Don't send payment. We will bill you.

Is financial aid available?

Yes. If you qualify for free or reduced-price school meals, you may qualify for financial aid. Contact jenny.alvermann@yinghuaacademy.org.

Can I opt out of the Aftercare fee that's bundled into the class price?

No. We've included a reduced-rate Aftercare with every class (and music lesson), so it's easier than ever to take classes. There is no option to take a class without being enrolled in Aftercare. Students can be picked up anytime, but have the option to stay as late as 6:00p.m. on class days.

How do I set Silent Dismissal when my student is enrolled in Enrichment?

Set Silent Dismissal for **AFTERCARE+Classes/Music Lessons** on any day your child has an Enrichment class. Students check in with Aftercare, and we escort them to class.

What happens if the minimum number of kids don't sign up for a class?

Sadly, we have to cancel classes that don't reach minimum numbers. We'll contact you via email if that happens.

Can I cancel a class?

Before September 8th, yes. After September 8th, no. We depend on enrollment numbers to determine if a class can run, so we consider you committed as of September 8th when registration closes. You will be billed for the class. Contact jenny.alvermann@yinghuaacademy.org if you have a concern about a class.

When do classes start?

Classes begin the week of September 18th and end the week of November 6th. There are no classes Friday, October 6; Wednesday, October 18; Thursday, October 19; or Friday, October 20.

How long are classes?

Most classes are 45 minutes long. Check the catalog details for timing.

Where (and when) do I pick up my kids after Enrichment classes?

Show your orange dismissal card and sign out your child at Door 2. We'll call for your student when you signed out.

What if my kids are sick or someone else has to pick them up?

Call the office and let us know if your kids won't be in a class. If someone else is picking them up, that person will need to show your dismissal card.

What else do I need to know?

Please remind your students that behavior expectations for Aftercare and Enrichment are the same as they are in the classroom.

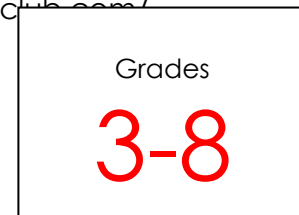

NEW! We're all familiar with English idioms: *A penny for your thoughts*, or *at the drop of a hat*, or *barking up the wrong tree*. We don't take the meaning literally, yet they are commonly understood phrases. Much the same are Chinese idioms (called Chengyu), four-character phrases that are used to convey a particular thought or feeling. Learning Chinese idioms helps increase understanding of the language. Idioms can also improve students' writing levels and increase their cultural appreciation. This class introduces new idioms each week in a fun way – with short, funny videos and creative projects. The students will create a short play at the end of the session using the idioms they've learned.

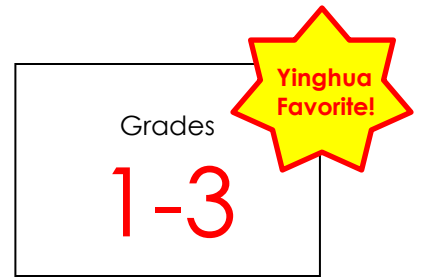

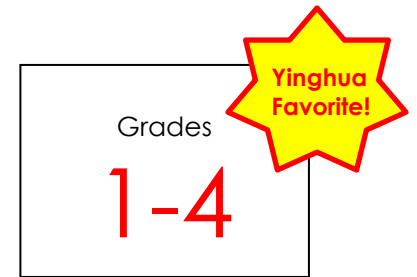

How to register for Session I Enrichment Classes

Registration is online and paperless! Registration closes at 5 p.m. Friday, September 5.

1. Go to yinghuaacademy.org > Current families > After school > Enrichment Program, and click on Fall Enrichment Registration.
2. Fill in your student's name. Add grade and section (e.g., 2A). Fill in your name and contact information.
3. Using the selection buttons, click on the classes for which you'd like to register.
4. Double-check to make sure your form is correct, then click Submit.

That's it! Here's what happens next...

1. You'll receive a confirmation email and invoice the week of September 11. Your reduced-rate Aftercare fee will be included on the bill. The Aftercare fee is \$10 per class day; it's waived if you are already paying it via music lessons, or if you qualify for free or reduced lunch and you contact libby.pomroy@yinghuaacademy.org with that information.
2. You can pay your invoice via ACH, credit card or check. Drop off cash; drop off or mail checks; contact Jennifer Olsen in the Yinghua office to pay via credit card or ACH.
3. Set Silent Dismissal to AFTERCARE+Classes/Music Lessons on Enrichment days.
4. If a class is cancelled due to low enrollment, you'll get a notification via email.
5. Most classes start the week of September 18, and run through the week of November 6. Note that classes vary in length from a 4-week class to full 8-week classes. Check the class catalog to note the dates.
6. On class day, students in grades 2-8 with Enrichment classes go to the cafeteria at 3:30 dismissal. Students in grade 1 are escorted to the cafeteria. After check-in, students will be escorted to their classes by the Aftercare staff. After class, they return to Aftercare, where you can pick them up by 6:00 at Door 2.
