



CNY Dress Rehearsals at School, FRIDAY, February 10, 2017

- Student attire on 2/10: Wear regular uniforms over the “base layer” of your costume. The base layer is what your teacher asked you to wear under your costume (e.g., plain white tee-shirt and black leggings). Style hair per teacher’s instructions.
- Send snow gear for Kindergarten through 4th grade students. Weather permitting, they will have outdoor recess.
- Do not send folders or homework.
- Pictures: Portraits of students in costume take place at school on 2/10.
- A visiting Lion Dance team will entertain students between the two rehearsals today.
- Follow your lunch plan today (bag lunch from home or preordered school lunch).
- Arrival and dismissal follow normal procedures. Submit dismissal changes via Silent Dismissal as usual.

CNY Performances, Bethel U., SATURDAY, February 11, 2017

- Drop off students at Benson Great Hall, Bethel U., 3900 Bethel Drive, St. Paul 55112, per schedule on reverse.
- If you prefer, park in West Parking Lot and escort your child in.
- Staff and volunteers meet students in the Benson lobby, lead them to assigned classrooms. Students enrolled in onsite “Aftercare” will be escorted and chaperoned during all transitions today.
- **If your family has special arrival timing needs, inform your homeroom teacher.**
- Do not send anything valuable with students. LABEL EVERYTHING.
- Students may bring books or small toys. 5th-8th students may bring electronics. We are not responsible for lost belongings.
- For grades K through 4, send a front-closing shirt or large cloth to protect costumes when students eat or drink.
- If adult other than a parent/guardian will pick up a child after show, notify the teacher. Bring photo ID.
- Pick-up procedures:
 1. After show, pick up students in dismissal locations (on reverse) ASAP *except* 5th grade, 6th girls and 8th grade who need 15 minutes to change. Volunteers and ushers will direct you.
 2. Sign out your child on the teacher’s list. You may be asked to present an ID.
 3. After 20 minutes, students not picked up will be brought to the second floor AC Lounge to wait for you.
 4. If your family has special timing needs, inform homeroom teachers.

Notes for 11:30 Performers

- Drop off by 8:20 or 8:40 a.m. according to the timetable above.
- **MORNING PERFORMERS NEED TO BRING THEIR OWN LUNCHES TODAY!** Also send additional snacks and labeled water bottle.
- Doors to the hall open at **10:45 a.m. for audience seating.** Please do not visit classrooms beforehand.

Notes for 4:30 Performers

- Drop off by 1:00 or 1:15 p.m. according to the timetable above.
- Allow plenty of time for drop off because traffic between the two shows will be heavy.
- Pack substantial snacks and water in a labeled water bottle.
- Doors to the hall open at **3:45 p.m. for audience seating.** Please do not visit classrooms beforehand.

If you have children in *both* performances...

- If you have children watching the first show before performing at 4:30, watch the first show together then walk your 4:30-performer to his/her drop off classroom before picking up your 11:30 performer.
- Remember, unless your child is a lap-sitter, he/she must have a ticket.
