Responsibilities include:

- Make sure house is tidy before doors open.
- Open doors to house at designated times.
- In central atrium of the building, direct guests to the entrance closest to their seats.
- Distribute programs.
- Offer directions to restrooms. Answer general questions.
- Help guests find seats inside the hall.
- Remain at an entrance to the house during performance to assist latecomers and aide others who may need to exit during the performance.
- Direct parents/guardians to students' pick up sites.
- Aide with basic clean-up in house. Collect any lost/found items, collect leftover programs. Pick up trash, if any.
