How do I sign up?

Registration is online now; see the last page of this catalog for instructions. Sign up by Friday, December 11. DO NOT send payment; we'll bill you.

Is financial aid available?

Yes, if you qualify for free or reduced-price school meals at Yinghua, you may qualify for financial aid.

Can I opt out of the Aftercare fee that's bundled into the class price?

No, we've included a reduced-rate Aftercare with every class (and music lesson), so it's easier than ever to take classes. There is no option to take a class without being enrolled in Aftercare. Students can be picked up anytime, but have the option to stay as late as 6:00 on class days.

How do I set Silent Dismissal when my student is enrolled in Enrichment?

Set Silent Dismissal for AFTERCARE on any day your child has an Enrichment class. They check in with Aftercare, and we escort them to class.

What happens if the minimum number of kids don't sign up for a class?

Sadly, we have to cancel classes that don't reach minimum numbers. We'll contact you via email if that happens.

Can I cancel a class?

No, we depend on enrollment numbers to determine if a class can run, so we consider you committed as of December 11 when registration closes. You will be billed for the class.

When do classes start?

Classes begin the week of January 4, once a week for eight weeks, ending the week February 29. There are NO ENRICHMENT CLASSES the week of February 15. Monday classes do not meet January 18, February 8, or February 15; Monday classes meet 6 times.

How long are classes?

Most classes are 45 minutes in length. Exceptions are Chess Club and Lego Enginetics (1 hour long); Yinghua Choir runs 30 minutes. Minecraft Game Designer, 3-D Programming and Illustration from your Imagination run 4 weeks, but the class is 90 minutes long.

Where (and when) do I pick up my kids after Enrichment classes?

Every enrichment student needs to be signed out at our Aftercare table near door 2. We'll call for your student when you have signed out.

What if my kids are sick, or someone else has to pick them up?

Call the office and let us know if your kids won't be there. If someone else is picking them up, let the office know; that person will need to show an ID.

What else do I need to know?

Please remind your students that behavior expectations for Aftercare and Enrichment are the same as they are in the classroom







Registration is online and paperless! Registration closes at 5 p.m. Friday, December 11.

NEW THIS YEAR: Payment for Enrichment classes is via ACH or credit/debit card. No checks.

- 1. Go to yinghuaacademy.org/currentfamilies/enrichment, and click on Term II Registration Form.
- 2. Fill in your student's name. Add grade and section (e.g., 2A). Fill in your name and contact information.
- Using the selection buttons, click on the classes for which you'd like to register.
- 4. Double-check to make sure your form is correct, then click Submit.

That's it! Here's what happens next...

- 1. You'll receive a confirmation email and invoice later in December. Your reduced-rate Aftercare fee will be included on the bill. The Aftercare fee is \$10 per class day; it's waived if you are already paying it via music lessons.
- 2. You can pay your invoice via ACH or by credit or debit card. NO PAPER CHECKS ACCEPTED. Contact <u>Jennifer Olsen</u> in the Yinghua office to make your payment: 612-788-9095 or jennifer.olsen@yinghuaacademy.org.
- 3. Set Silent Dismissal to AFTERCARE on Enrichment days.
- 4. If a class is cancelled due to low enrollment, you'll get a notification via email.
- 5. Classes start the week of January 4, and run through March 4. No classes the week of February 15.
- 6. On class day, students in grades 2-8 with Enrichment classes go to the cafeteria at 3:30 dismissal. Students in grades K and 1 are escorted to the cafeteria. After check-in, students will be escorted to their classes by the Aftercare staff. After class, they return to Aftercare, where you can pick them up by 6:00 at Door 2.
