Electronic Ballot, By Email

- Up to two ballots will be accepted from each email address provided we have two parents on file for the family associated with that email address (if part of a two-parent family, each parent can vote)

Paper Ballot, In Person

- Submit your ballot to the ballot box in the school's main office (available May 7 May 14)
- Paper ballots will be available at the Annual Meeting in the Cafeteria on May 7 at 6:00 PM
- Your paper ballot must be submitted in a **sealed envelope**; and you must **print** *and* **sign your name over the seal**. Please print legibly, so eligible voters can be tracked to ensure no one can submit more than one ballot.

Paper Ballot, By US Mail

- Submit your ballot by postal mail to the school (must arrive by May 14 at 6:00 PM)
- Your ballot must be submitted in a **sealed envelope**; and you must **print** *and* **sign your name over the seal**. Please print legibly, so eligible voters can be tracked to ensure no one can submit more than one ballot.
