Two different levels classes in term 2:

- 1. Competitive class: 2 practices (or more) per week; Tuesday 3:45- 5:45 and Saturday 9:00 12:00 in the gym at Yinghua. Monday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday 4:00- 6:00 at Twin Cities Fencing Club at St. Paul (It is optional for practicing in St. Paul). If we attend a weekend fencing tournament, this will replace the Saturday practice. We will notify you of this well in advance. \$450 + \$50 equipment rental fee + \$100 deposit per term.
- 2. Beginner class:1 or 2 practices per week (you decide); Tuesday 3:45-5:15 or Saturday 9:00 11:00
- One practice per week \$200 + \$50 equipment rental fee +\$100 deposit per term
- Two practices per week \$400 + \$50 equipment rental fee + \$100 deposit per term

Grade $6^{th} - 8^{th}$ and Yighua alumni:

Eligible for either beginner and competitive
