



# Yinghua Fencing Camp

A Summer Chinese Immersion Camp, 2020

Coach Dong-Ying Pai invites students in grades two through five to join him at Yinghua this summer to have fun learning the fast, elegant, and **safe** sport of fencing! Note: This camp is taught in Chinese.

Campers will:

- Learn basic footwork, and fencing rules.
- Practice blade drills.
- Enjoy fencing games.
- Participate in **real** fencing bouts.

*No prior fencing experience is necessary. Students who choose to enroll in both Yinghua's Fencing camp and Yinghua Academy's Chinese Language Camp will be assisted in transitioning from one camp to another. Campers participating in both camps must bring a lunch daily. Aftercare is available from 12 to 1:00 pm and 4-6:00 pm. See below for aftercare details.*

## Camp Dates and Times

Session 1: July 20-24 2020, 1:00 to 4:00 PM

Session 2: July 27-31 2020, 1:00 to 4:00 PM

## Age of Campers

Each session of camp is open to students entering grades two through five.



## Registration and Fees:

- Registration runs **through April 30**; class space is limited.

- Fee: \$180 per session, per child. The use of fencing equipment and a camp t-shirt included.

- Session size: 8 students minimum, campers may attend both sessions.

## Withdrawal Policy

- Withdrawals prior to July 6 receive a tuition refund, less a \$25 administrative fee.
- Withdrawals July 6-17 receive a 50% refund.
- **No camp or aftercare refunds are offered for withdrawals July 18 or later.**

## What to Bring

Students must wear comfortable athletic shoes and athletic clothing. Bring a name-labeled water bottle.

## Aftercare and Late Pickups

Fencing campers who need Aftercare, from 12-1:00 pm and /or 4 to 6 p.m. on Fencing Camp days, pay just \$10 per student, per day. The fee for late pickup is \$1 per minute (the same as Yinghua Aftercare during the school year).
