531 THE PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

I. PURPOSE

The school board recognizes the need to display an appropriate United States flag and to provide instruction to students in the proper etiquette, display, and respect of the flag. The purpose of this policy is to address recitation of the Pledge of Allegiance and instruction in school to help further that end.

II. GENERAL STATEMENT OF POLICY

Students in Yinghua Academy are not required to recite the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag of the United States of America on a weekly basis.

III. INSTRUCTION

All students will be taught the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag of the United States of America in both English and Chinese. As part of the School's curriculum, students will be instructed in the proper etiquette toward, correct display of, and respect for the flag, and in patriotic exercises.
