Welcome to the 2025–2026 school year! As we begin this new academic year, I am filled with joy and gratitude to celebrate Yinghua Academy's 20th anniversary with all of you. This milestone is a testament to how far we have come and to our shared commitment to nurturing students to become compassionate, collaborative, confident, creative, and critical-thinking bilingual global citizens—ready to shape a brighter future.

Kickoff Celebration: 20th Anniversary Community Picnic

Our 20th anniversary celebration will continue throughout the year as we reflect on two decades of excellence and growth. To begin this momentous year, we warmly invite all students, families, staff, and alumni to join us for our Community Picnic on Friday, September 5. This joyful gathering will be a wonderful opportunity to reconnect, welcome new friends, and celebrate our vibrant school community. Each guest will receive a commemorative 20th anniversary t-shirt! (See the enclosed flyer for details.) As I look back on our journey, I'm reminded that Yinghua has always been grounded in its mission and guided by the needs of our students. Staying true to our purpose—and placing children at the center of our work—remains the key to everything we do.

Student-Centered Enhancements for 2025-2026

This year, we continue to strengthen student learning and well-being by deepening connections, improving instructional design, and expanding joyful learning opportunities. To ensure our students have a strong foundation, we are returning to essential skills that will reinforce their academic base and prepare them for the next stages of learning.

Highlights include:

Focus on Reading and Literacy Skills: Our Academic Team has reviewed how we prepare students to read and developed plans to help them engage in meaningful experiences such as read-alouds, silent reading, and guided reading—nurturing a lifelong love of books and learning. Reading classes have been added for grades 2–4, and dedicated small-group learning time will further enhance students' literacy skills. Our Chinese and English teaching teams are also working closely together to identify learning gaps and ensure each language supports the other for a more comprehensive literacy development.

New Class Schedule for Grades 2–8: To foster stronger relationships and more personalized instruction, we are refining our daily schedule:

- All Grades will begin and end each day in homeroom with Morning Meeting and Homework Time, helping to build consistency and support students' social-emotional development.
- During academic periods, students will be assigned into smaller instructional groups:
 - Grades 2-3: Three homerooms per grade level, with six learning groups across the grade
 - Grades 4–6: Three homerooms per grade level, with four learning groups across the grade

These updates will be shared in more detail during Curriculum Nights on September 9 and 11.

Expanded Small Group Instruction: We are proud to continue strengthening our differentiated instruction model, ensuring that every student receives meaningful support and enrichment:

- Intervention groups will focus on reinforcing foundational academic skills.
- Enrichment groups will offer advanced learning opportunities and creative challenges.

Early Literacy Screenings (Kindergarten-Grade 3): In alignment with the Minnesota READ Act, we will conduct one-on-one literacy assessments to better understand and support our early learners:

- Kindergarten: Screenings will take place during Meet Your Teacher Night (families are welcome to observe) or within the first six weeks of school.
- · Grade 1: Within the first six weeks of school.
- Grade 2: On August 19 by appointment (see enclosed information) or within the first six weeks
 of school.
- Grade 3: Within the first two weeks of school.

Expanded After-School and Enrichment Programs: We are excited to offer an even broader range of Extended Programs this year—especially for our middle school students. New activity offerings include K-Pop Dance, Technovation, Math Olympiad, Dungeons & Dragons, and more!

We are also continuing to strengthen our Chinese immersion enrichment through activities such as outdoor games, traditional play, and social hours conducted entirely in Chinese—providing fun, engaging, and meaningful ways to deepen both language skills and cultural understanding. (The full Extended Programs Catalog will be available on August 12.)

Healthy Snack Initiative: As part of our commitment to student wellness, we are launching a *Healthy Snack Initiative* in our After-School/Extended Learning Program. In alignment with state nutrition guidelines, this pilot program will phase out juice boxes and introduce more fresh fruits, vegetables, and whole grains—helping students build healthy habits and stay energized for active learning.

Class Placement and Communication

Our academic team thoughtfully considered each child's learning needs, social dynamics, and teacher input when creating class rosters. Class placements will be shared via Infinite Campus Messages on the evening of August 24, just before Meet Your Teacher Night.

Thank you for your trust, partnership, and continued support. Let's make this 20th anniversary year not only a celebration of our past, but also a bold step forward—honoring our mission, strengthening our community, and helping every student shine.
